Technical Evaluation

Tactical Evaluation — Player Multifunctionality

Analysis of usefulness within different tactical roles of modern football: Inverted Fullback, Anchor (Holding Midfielder), Inverted Wing-Back, Build-Up Pivot, Holding Pivot, Covering Midfielder, Box-to-Box Midfielder, Half-Space Playmaker, Inverted Winger, Possession Winger, Wide Interior Midfielder, False Nine.

Objective: promote player multifunctionality and tactical versatility, increasing the likelihood that the player will earn playing time, develop, and succeed.

Competitive Benchmarking

The player's performance benchmarked against: the best player in the league at his position, the best player of his nationality at his position, and the best player in the world at his position.

Determines the player's realistic competitive positioning within the professional football market.

Career Risk Diagnostics
